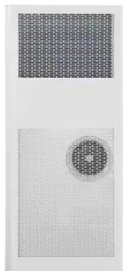


Tail shape what do you prefer?

A Rounded Square tail combines the performance of a round tail and a square tail, great all round performance for most types of waves. Board suited for this tail - performance short boards,

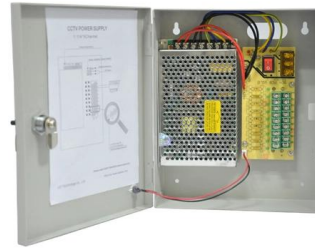

Round Tails Round tail shapes are longer than square tails, reaching farther into the wave and allowing for smoother, more drawn-out turns done in small or large surf.





Basic Tail Shapes

A round or pin tail will hold the water longer making it stable in bigger surf. A square or angular tail will release water making it looser, skatier and snappy. Different shapes will change the width of the tail,
