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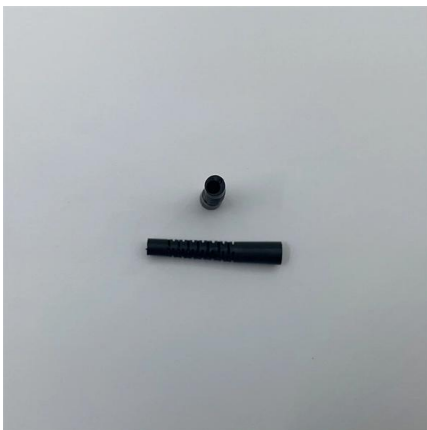


The FOA Reference For Fiber Optics

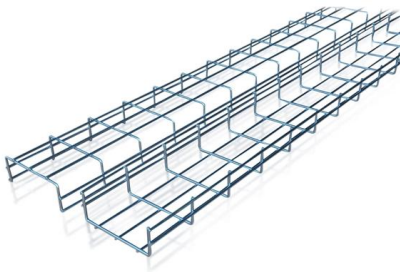

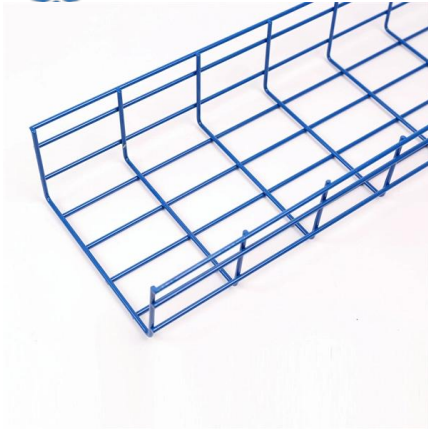

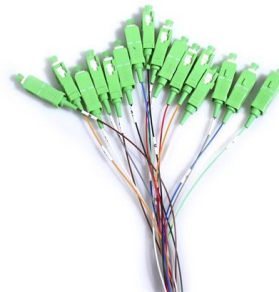

Fiber optic cables use light to transmit data, instead of electricity as in twisted pair cables. Different types of fiber optic cables have their own specific structure.



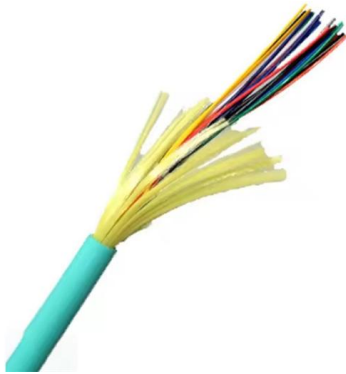
Cross-sectional diagram of the optical cable.

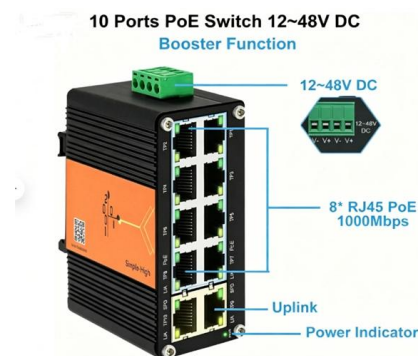

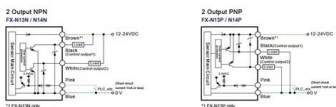

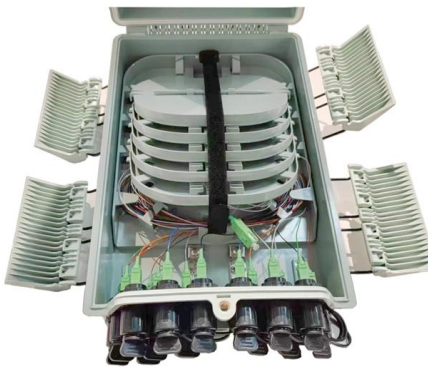

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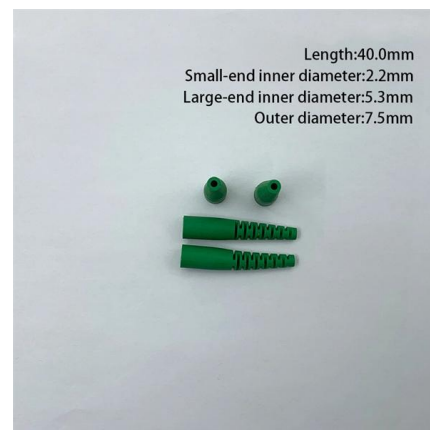
