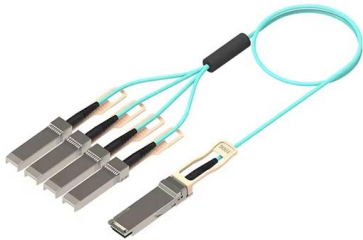

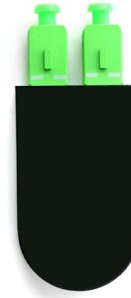

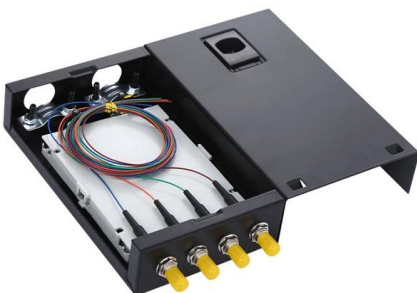

On the Options Bar, specify cable tray options. Drag the control to move or extend the cable tray segment to a new endpoint, or to connect with another cable tray.



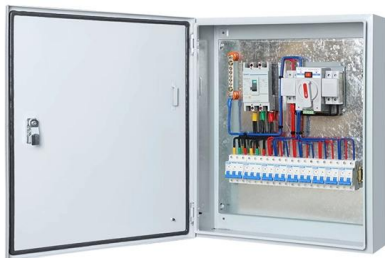
How to change the default height of cable trays in Revit
