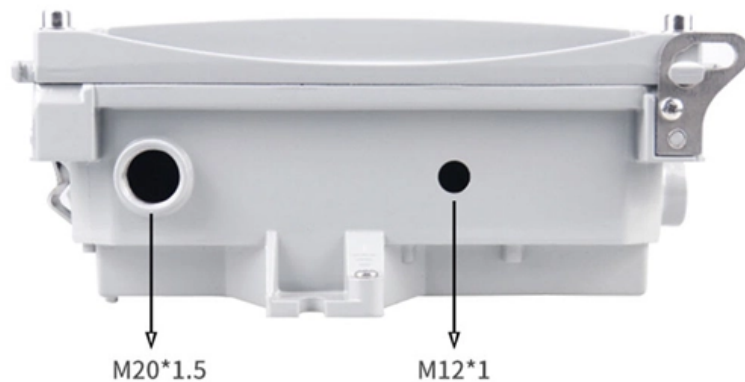

SA Home Distribution Boards generally seem to have the breaker switches running horizontally next to each other in the panel cutouts - is there any reason why they are like this and is it permissible to mount them vertically instead?

Reason for asking is that my current DB is too small and crowded. The service entrance is from below and I'd like the breakers at the top of the box instead of the bottom for space reasons. In the past, electricians would often install outlets with the grounding slot facing upwards to prevent water from entering the outlet.

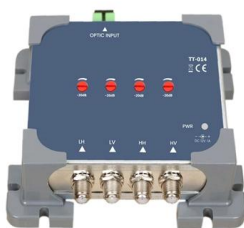

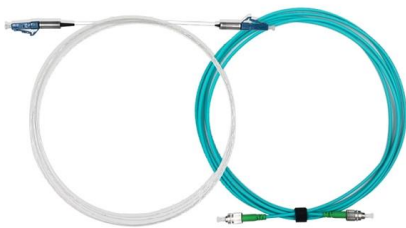

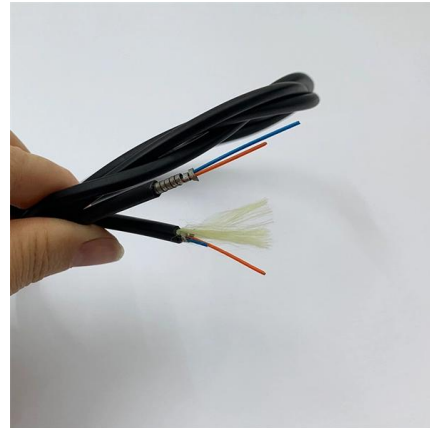
