## Overview

Don't currently have a power meter (ordered, on its way), and was curious if there is any impact on power consumption by turning off unused ports, both PoE and non-PoE?

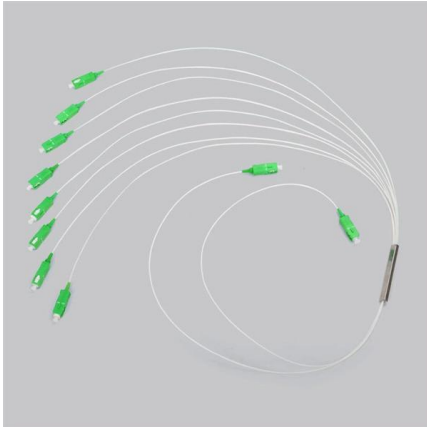

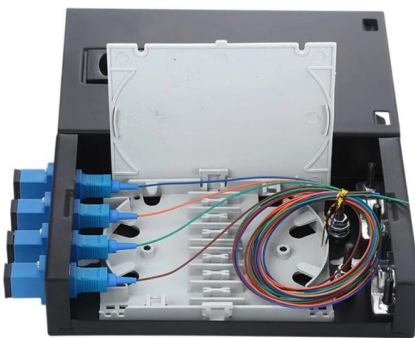

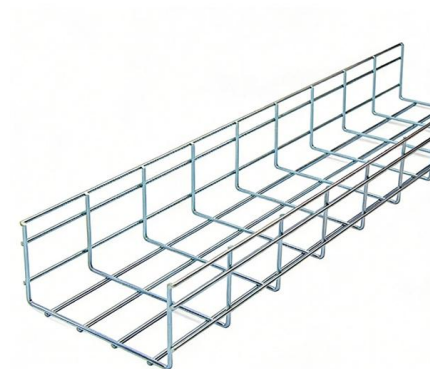

In some high-speed transmission Ethernet chips, leaving unused ports floating may lead to signal reflection, resulting in noise and interference within the circuit.

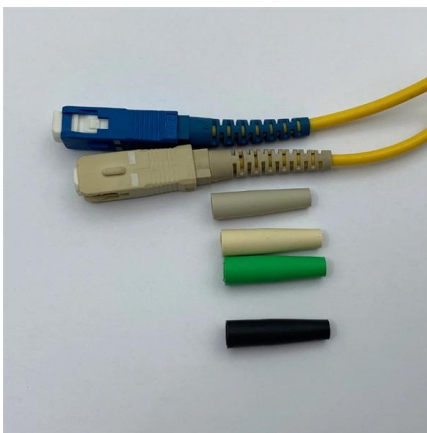

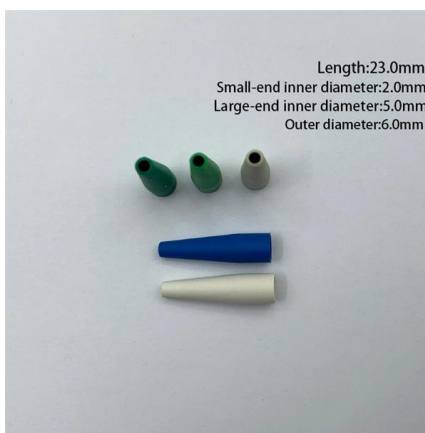
## Solved: Finding Unused Switchports

When this switch was installed, the installer connected every port on the patch panel to a port on the switch, so I can't tell which ports actually have a device on the other end of the patch



## TS5A23166: Handling Unused Ports

If not used, can the IN pin be handled as Not Connect or Open? These devices are NC (Normally Closed) at Vcc: 0v, I think there is no need to control the IN port.
