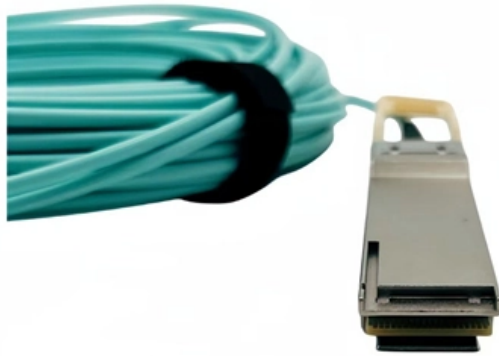

Overview

The 2Africa submarine cable system, which spans 33 countries across Africa, Europe and Asia, is designed to deliver up to 180 Tbps capacity and is expected to accelerate cross-border connectivity and enhance strategic international digital linkages. According to the Tech Review Africa and Chinese Xinhua News, China Mobile officially activated 2Africa East Segment Submarine Cable on November 7, 2025, with an aim to power digital transformation across the African continent. The initiative aligns with Kenya's Digital Superhighway and Creative Pillar agenda, which aims to deploy 100,000 kilometers of national fibre optic cable, establish 25,000 public Wi-Fi hotspots, build ICT hubs in every ward, and expand access to online government services. The 2Africa project is a collaboration between China Mobile and several international telecom operators, including Meta (formerly Facebook), Vodafone, Orange, Center3 (formerly STC), Bayobab (formerly MTN), WIOCC, and Telecom Egypt. The launch of 2Africa enables us to offer our customers seamless connection between Africa and Europe, together with our SEA-ME-WE 5 and AAE-1 subsea cable resources to further extend to Asia, which is an important milestone of our global development strategy," said Jessica Gu, Director & Chief. 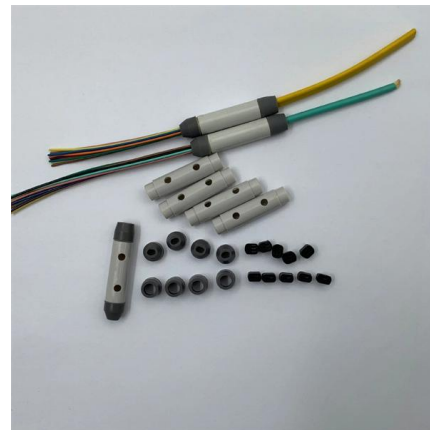

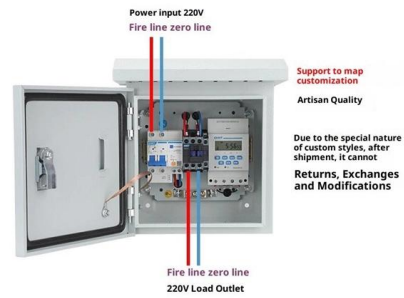
