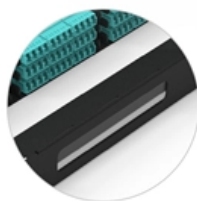

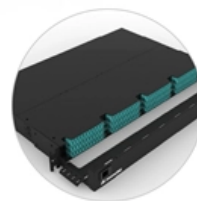

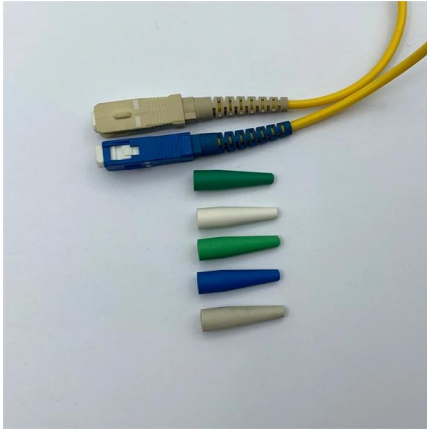


Overview
