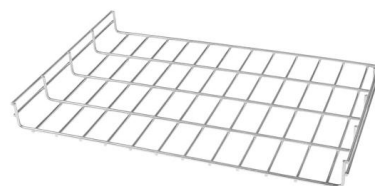


What is Port Mirroring or SPAN?

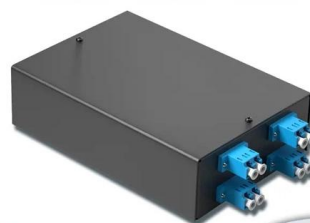
