Overview

It can occur due to overloaded circuits, short circuits, or ground faults.

Solution: Identify the Cause: Check if the breaker is tripping due to overloading. Frequent tripping of your distribution box is a critical alarm, not just an annoyance. 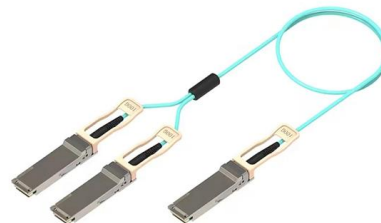

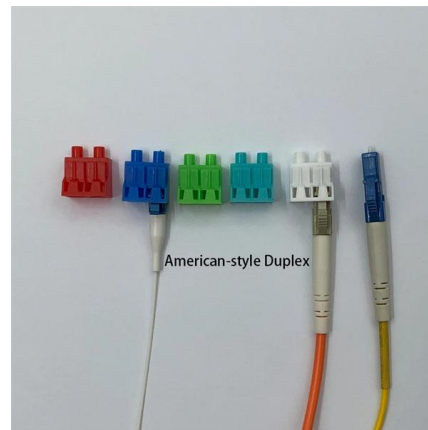

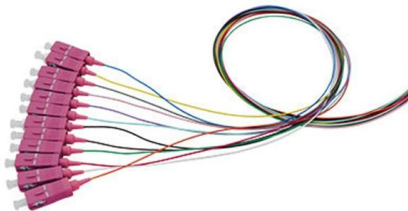
