Overview

Carbon steel used for cable trays shall be protected against corrosion by the following processes: Hot-dip galvanized zinc after fabrication in accordance with ASTM A123/A123M, Coating Grade 65 with an average zinc coating weight of 460 g/m² per side or coating thickness of. * It is recommended that where possible non-metallic banding is used in order to avoid rust stains forming on galvanized products and contamination of stainless steel products. Where products of five metre lengths or above are packed in bundles, they shall be supported with a minimum of three. A cable support system consists of cable support lengths and system components, such as cable support fittings, support elements, mounting.
