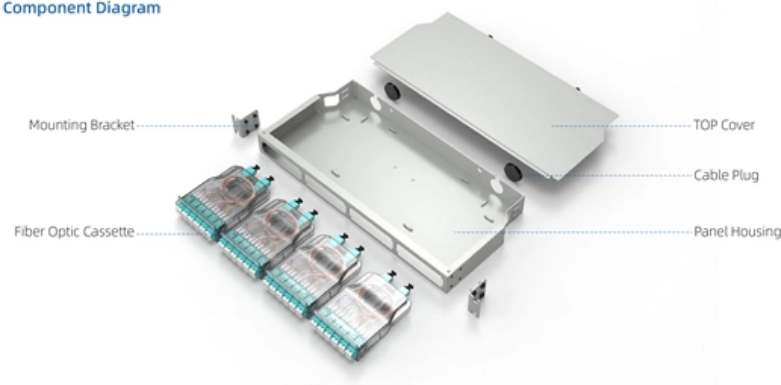


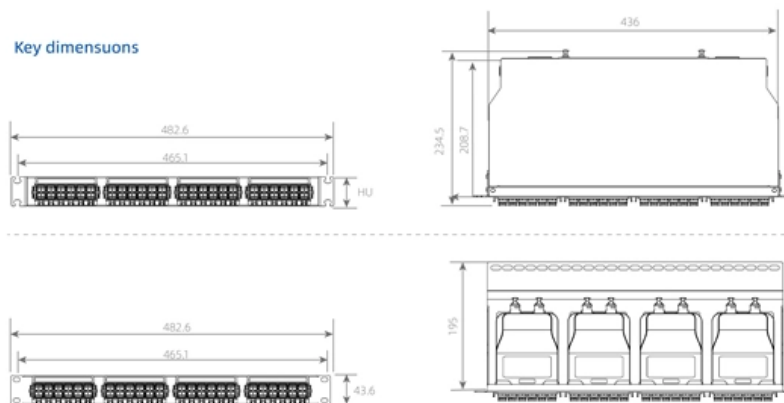

Unlike active devices (which require power), splitters operate without electricity, relying solely on the physics of light. They are crucial for network expansion, especially in scenarios where multiple locations need to be connected.
