Overview

An optical line termination (OLT), also called an optical line terminal, is a device which serves as the service provider endpoint of a passive optical network. Features OLTs include the following features:

- A downstream frame processing means for receiving and churning an cell to generate a downstream frame, and converting a parallel dat.

Most vendors integrate an entire fiber optic management system for ISPs to manage OLTs as well as client ONTs and as such are not interoperable.

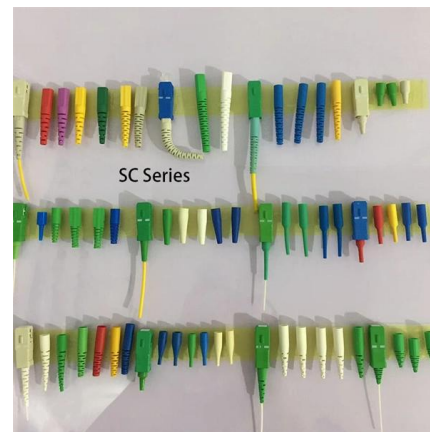
