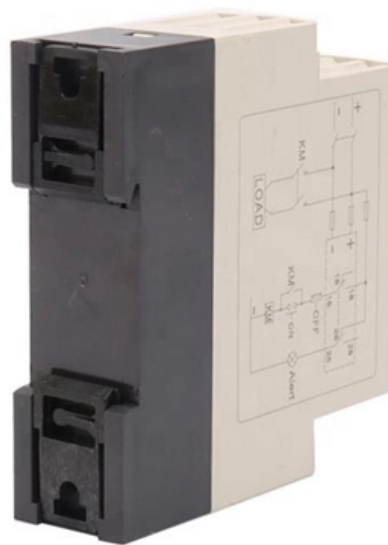

optic cabling systems (such as wall-mounted termination boxes, racks, and patch panels) must be grounded.

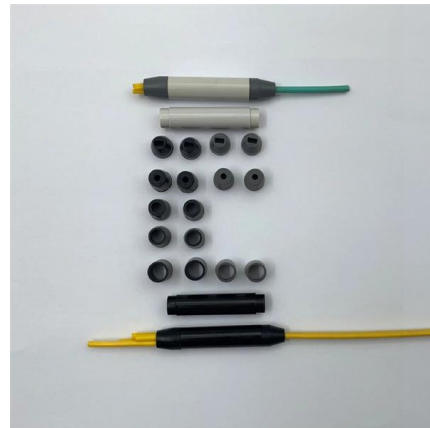

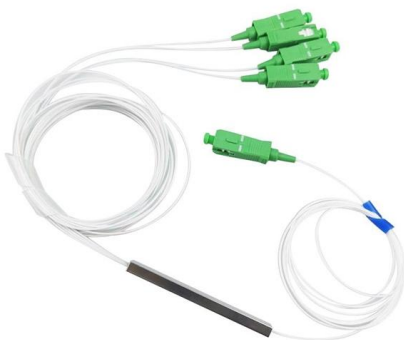

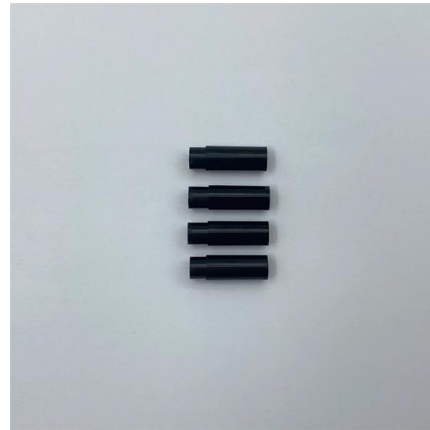

While fiber optic cables are typically stronger than copper cables, it is still important that the cable maximum pulling tension not be exceeded during any phase of cable installation.

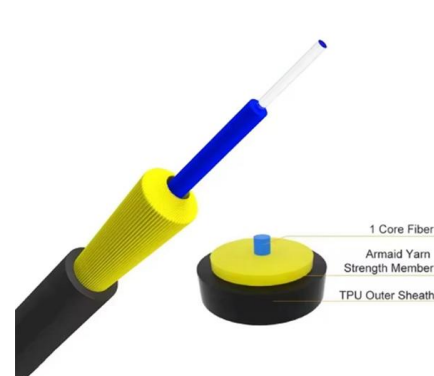
