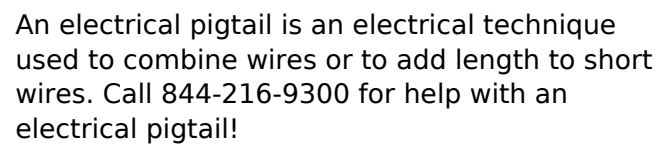

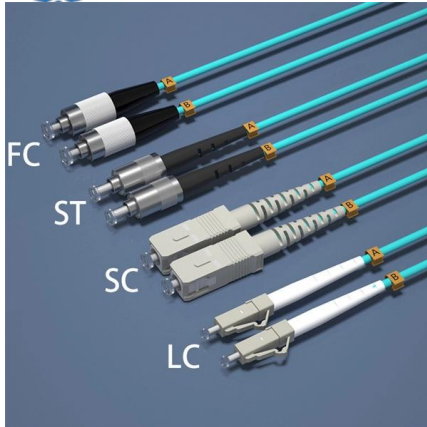

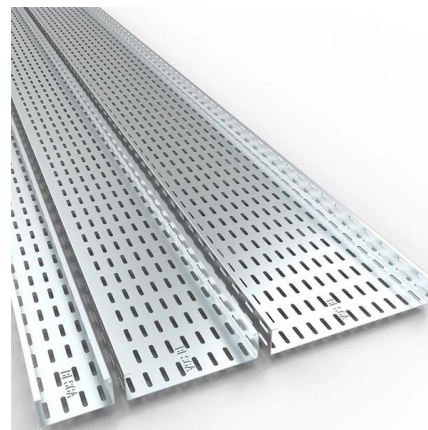


ST Fiber Optic Pigtail: ST pigtail connector is the most popular connector for multimode fiber optic LAN applications. It has a long 2.5mm

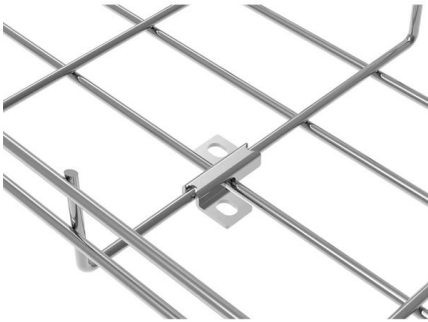
Each pigtail consists of a short length of 900mm tight-buffer fiber with a factory-installed connector on one end and an exposed fiber on the other. This design

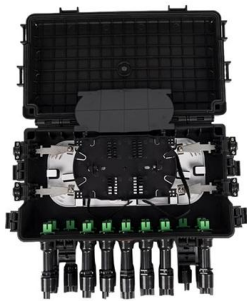

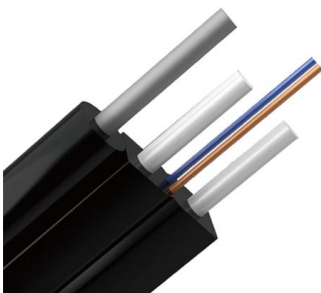

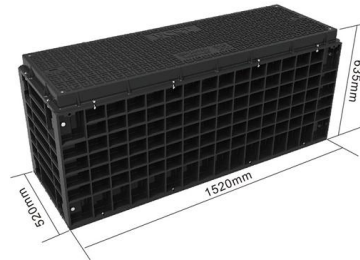
