What rack sizes are available?

They are available in different sizes from 1U to full racks (42U) and beyond. Important: U describes height only, but a server's real "capabilities" are also determined by chassis depth, internal layout, airflow, rails, power, and expansion (PCIe/risers, NVMe). A rack unit, abbreviated as U (or RU), is a standardized unit of measurement used to describe the vertical space occupied by equipment in a server rack. For example, a typical full-size rack cage is 42U high, while equipment is typically 1U, 2U, 3U, or 4U high. The rack unit size is based on a standard rack specification as defined in EIA -310. Most professional server racks follow the EIA-310 standard, which defines: These standards make it possible for any 19-inch compatible device to fit securely within the rack, regardless of brand.

Rack unit

A typical full-size rack is 42U, which means it holds just over 6 feet (180 cm) of equipment, and a typical "half-height" rack is 18U-22U, which is around 3 feet (91 cm) high. The mounting-hole distance (as shown to the right) differs for 19-inch racks and 23-inch racks: 19-inch racks use uneven spacings (as shown to the right) while 23-inch

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
