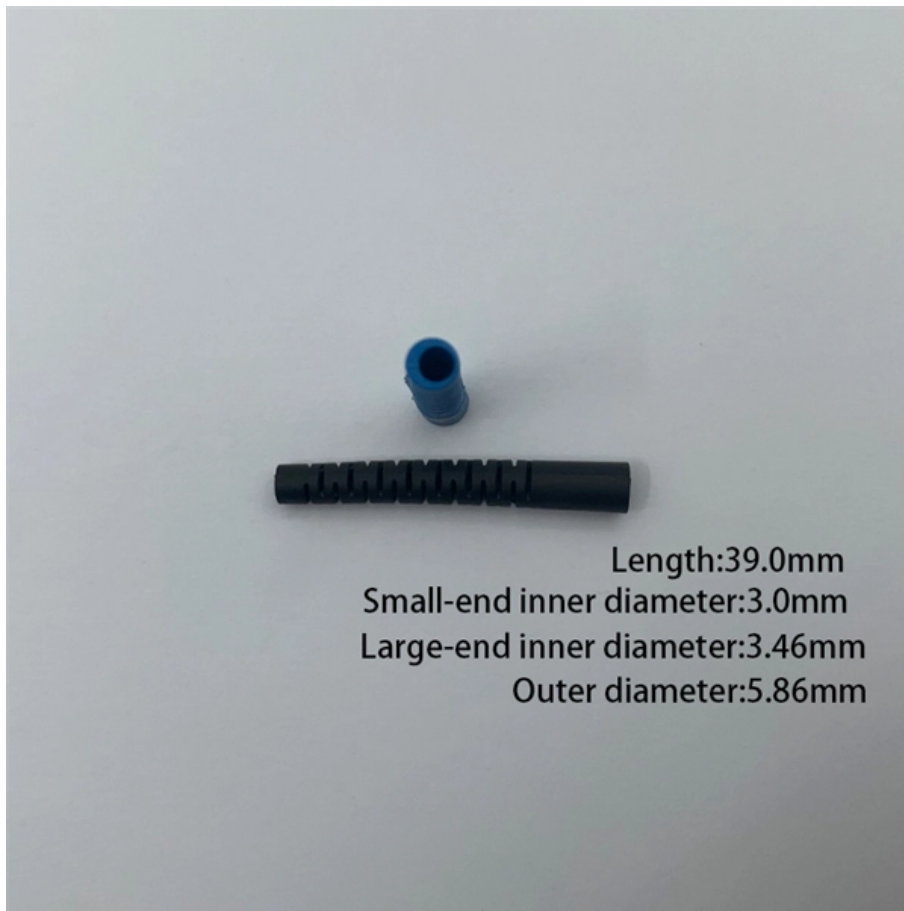

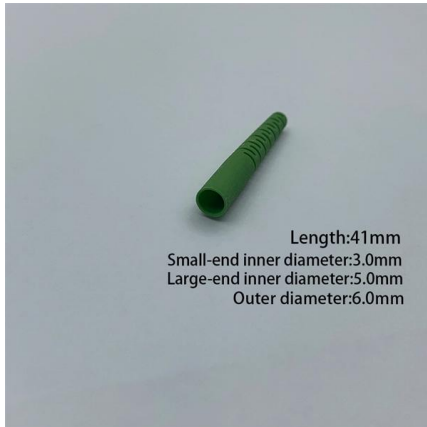


Overview
