A Rack Unit (U or RU) is the standard height measurement used for mounting equipment in server racks. Important: U describes height only, but a server's real "capabilities" are also determined by chassis depth, internal layout, airflow, rails, power, and expansion (PCIe/risers, NVMe). 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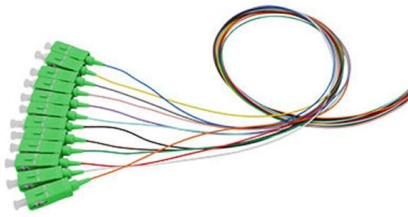

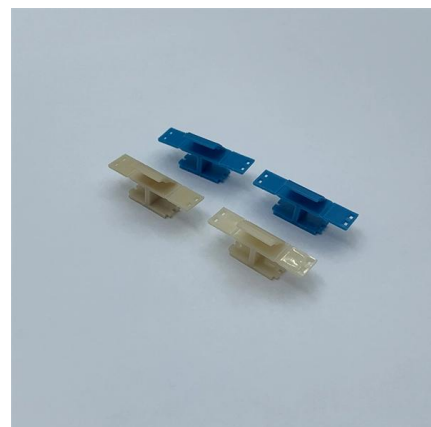
