Overview

This plug is separate from dash or lighting plugs and links directly to the SRS module. Move the seat forward or tilt it back so you can reach the primary plug without stretching the wires. Unplugging the yellow airbag connector can be necessary when performing certain vehicle repairs or replacing components near the airbag system. Step-by-Step Process: Follow the correct steps—locate, release the lock, and gently pull to unplug—to safely disconnect the airbag connector without causing damage. This should work on many cars including Scion, Lexus, Toyota, Nissan, Infinity, Honda, Acura, Mazda, Kia, Hyundai and more because they often share the same parts. It's pretty simple! An airbag connector works in your car to ensure a stable electrical connection between the electrical wiring or harness and the pyrotechnic airbag.

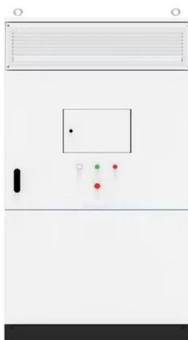

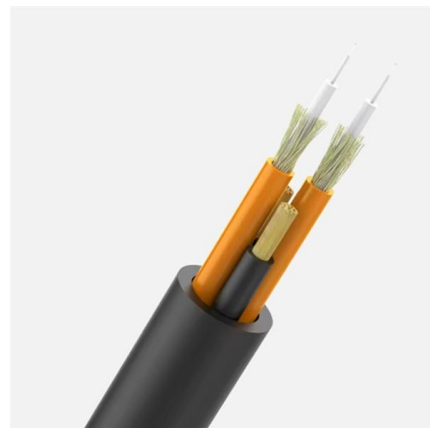
