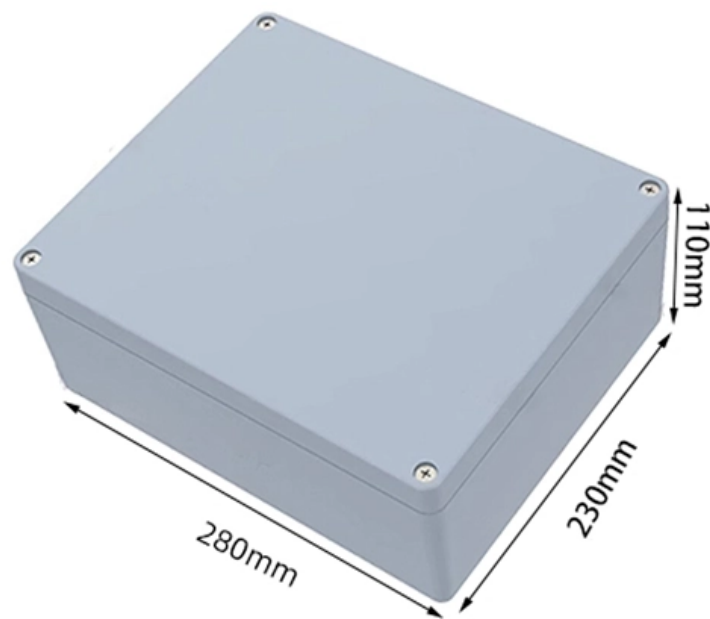

Firstly, using f50 galvanized steel pipe or 50×50×5 galvanized angle iron around the distribution box, and make it 1.5~2 meters deep under the ground.

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.

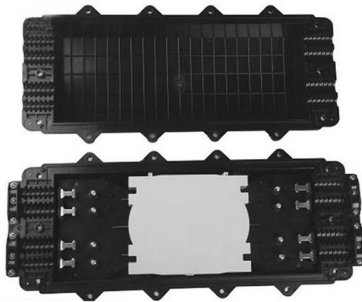
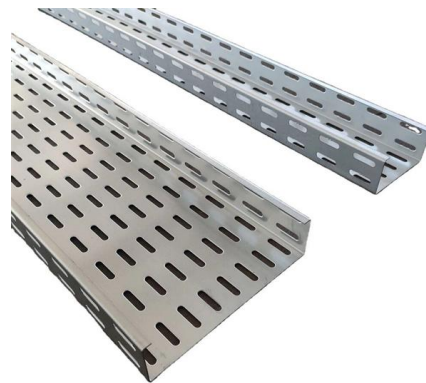

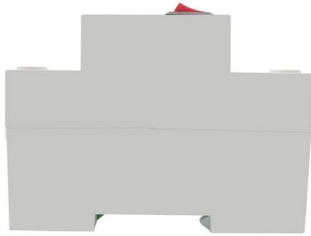
