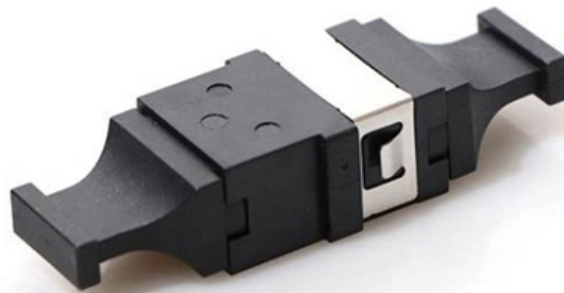

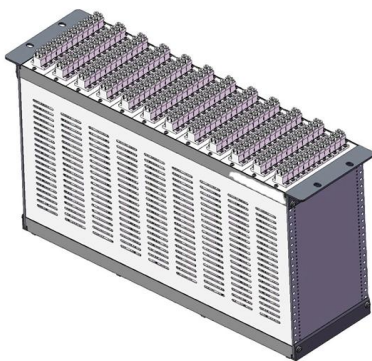
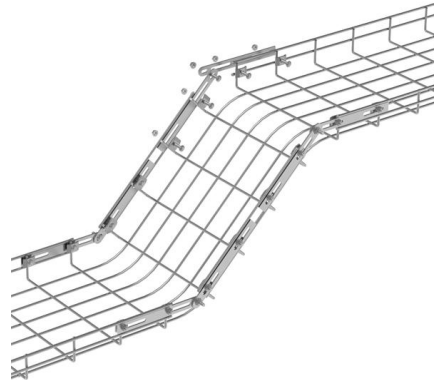
Education in Kyrgyzstan

According to the latest Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey, Kyrgyzstan maintains high rates of access to primary and basic secondary education of over 98 per cent.

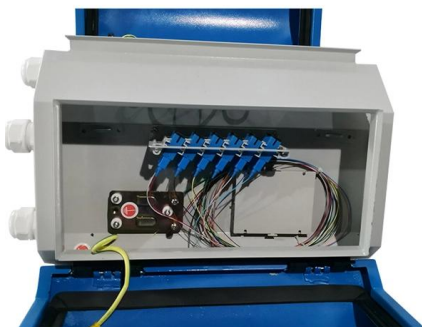
