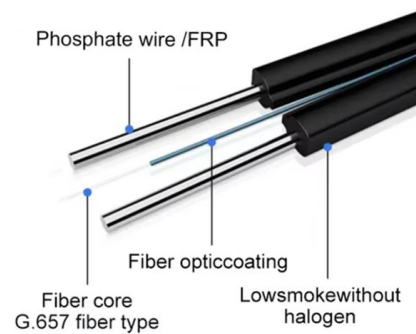

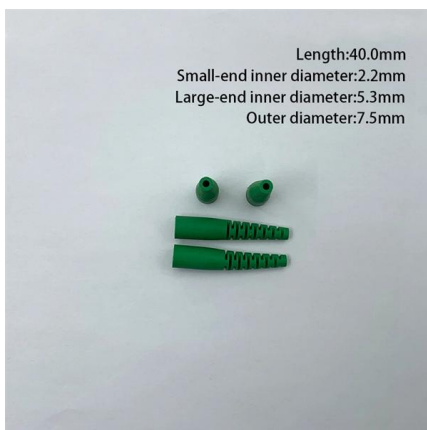

Beam Related Hazards Improperly used laser devices are potentially dangerous. Effects can range from mild skin burns to irreversible injury to the skin and eye.



Laser Safety in Ophthalmology

LASER devices are widely applied in ophthalmic, other medical, and non-medical settings. Thorough consideration of risks and proper usage are necessary for their safe applications.

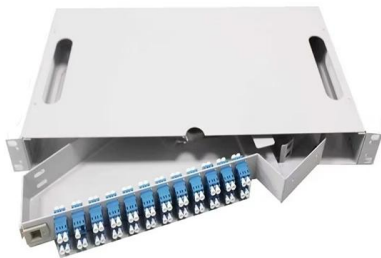

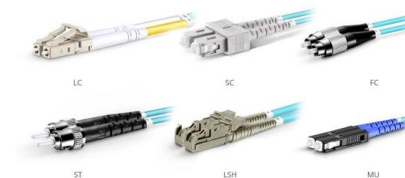

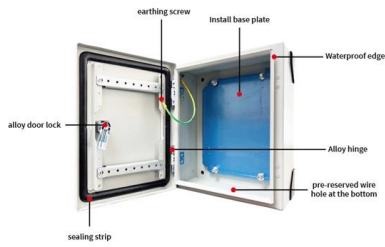
