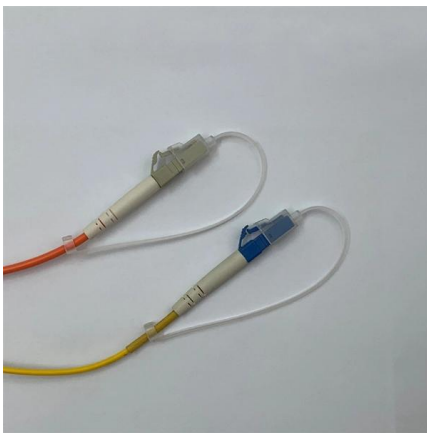
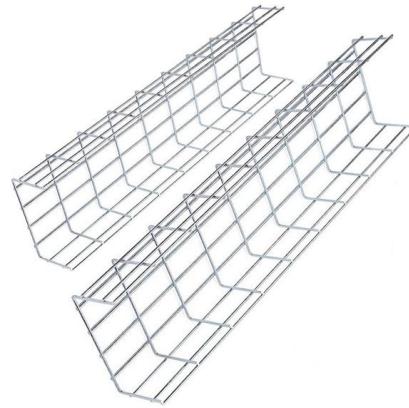

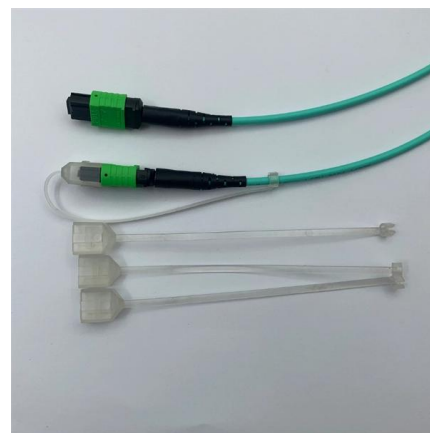


Can Control and Line Voltage Wires Be Run in the Same Conduit?

An optical ground wire (also known as an OPGW or, in the IEEE standard, an optical fiber composite overhead ground wire) is a type of cable that is used in overhead power lines.

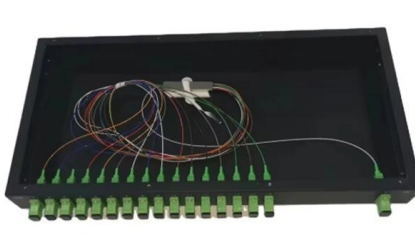

As long as any part of the LV cable jacket and/or internal wire insulation (if exposed in the JB) is rated for at least the max voltage on the power conductors in that same JB.

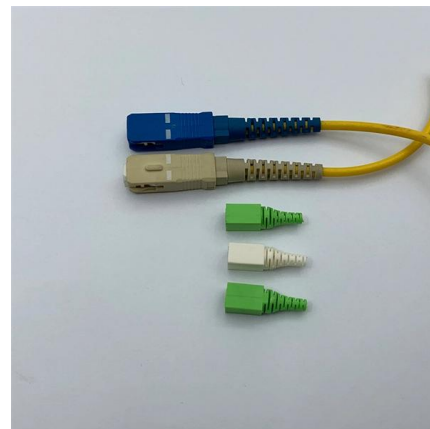


The FOA Reference For Fiber Optics -Outside Plant Construction
