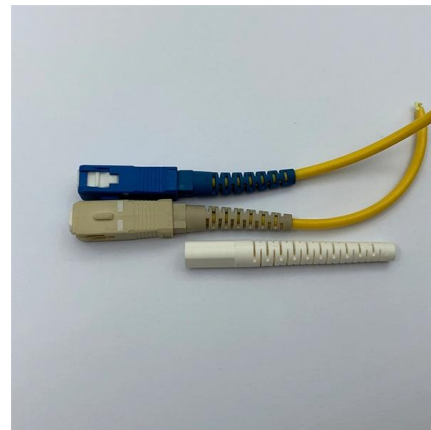

Submarine Cable Map , Interactive Global Undersea

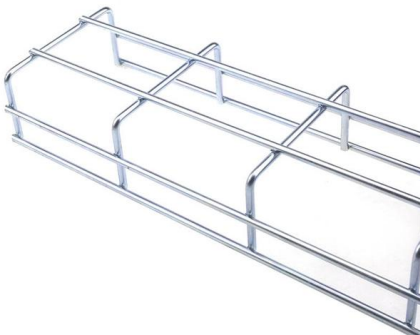

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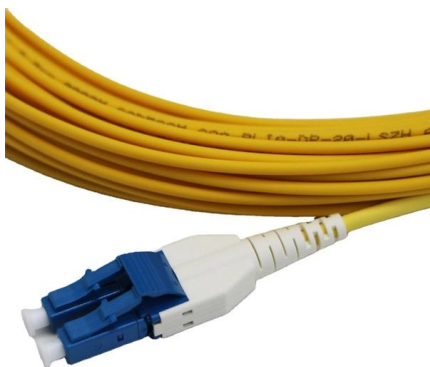

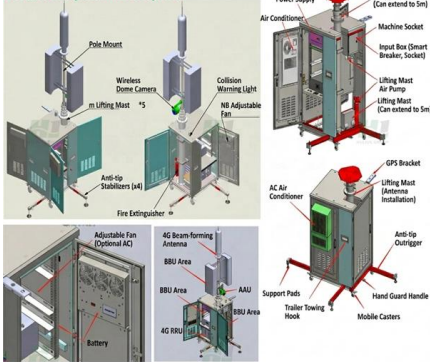

The East Micronesia Cable will provide high speed internet connectivity via submarine cable to Kosrae (FSM), Nauru and Tarawa (Kiribati).

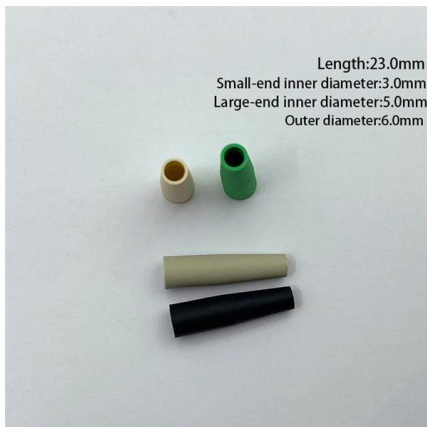

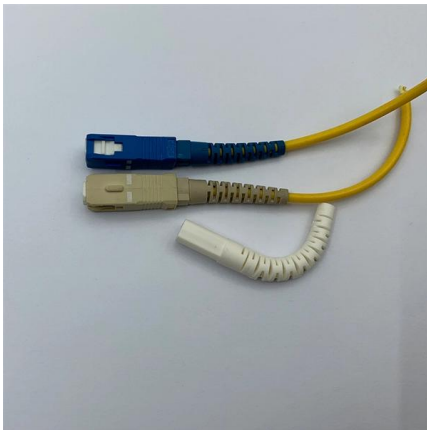
