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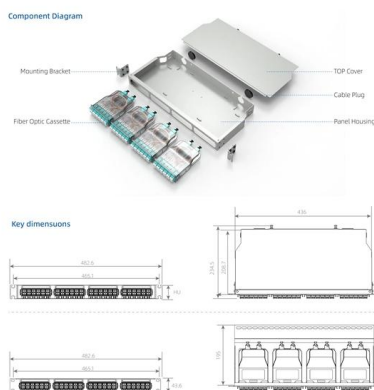


How to wire pigtails

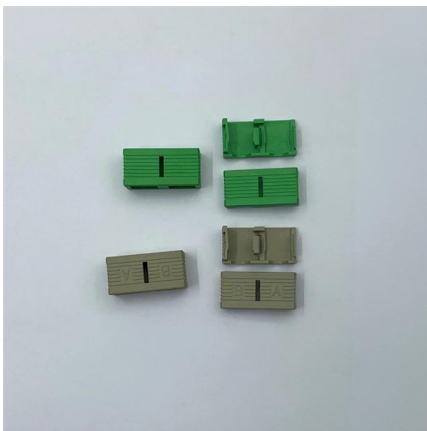
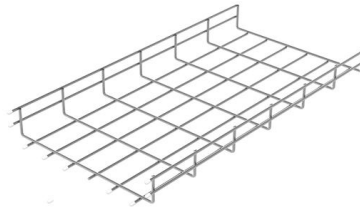

@300kHz @68kHz 22 AWG .64 mm 8.62 4.62

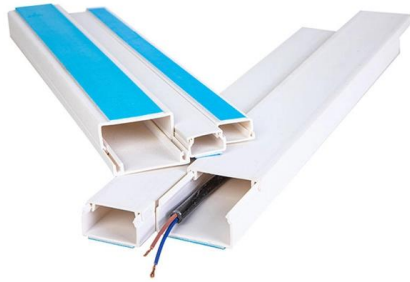

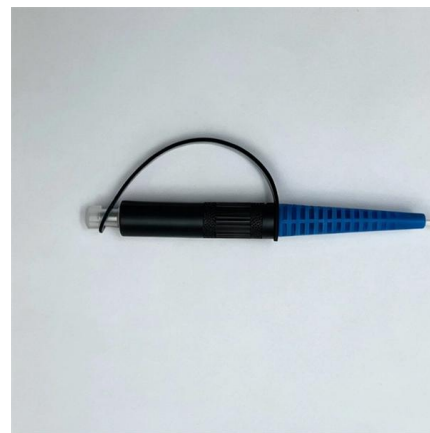
