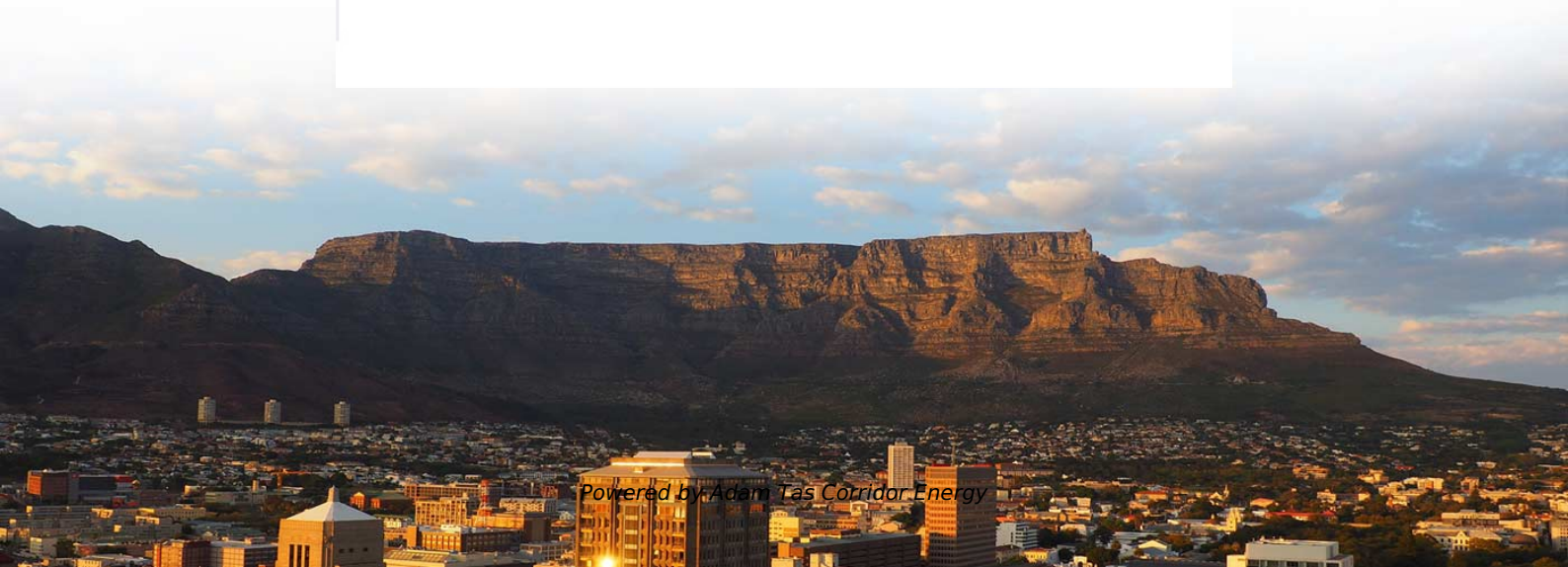

Prevention measures for knotting during optical cable laying





Overview

When laying loops of fiber on a surface during a pull, use "figure-8" loops to prevent twisting the cable. The figure 8 puts a half twist in on one side of the 8 and takes it out on the other, preventing twists. Minimize mechanical pressure on the outer sheath at crossing points: (armoured) cables crossing each other generate points of high pressure, so it is important when laying in figure 8 loops it is done in a correct way. Optical Fiber Cable Installation Guideline

Pull slowly and carefully lay the cable in the figure 8 pattern to prevent kinking. Each "8" should be slightly offset from the previous one to minimize mechanical pressure.
