Q. I have always thought that the best way to wire a receptacle is to use a pigtail lead from the supply wires to the receptacle. My electrician prefers to run

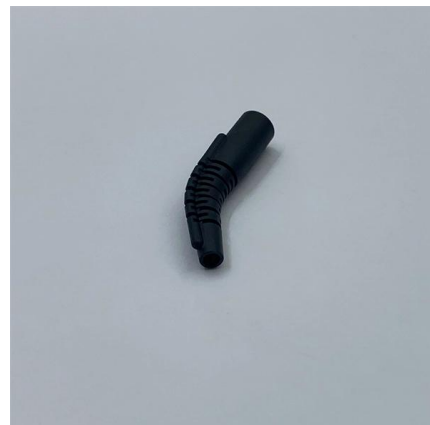


Requirements for Fabricated Frame Scaffolds

General Requirements The structural members of fabricated frame scaffolds such as the legs, poles, posts, frames and uprights shall be plumb and braced to prevent swaying and displacement.

Support frames

For "horizontal" frame formwork, the support frames must be positioned immediately behind the formwork at the tie holes. The frames are fastened with the waler spanners and tension nuts.
