The IEC 60446 standard, "Basic and Safety Principles for Man-Machine Interface, Marking, and Identification," establishes global guidelines for identifying electrical equipment terminals, conductors, and wiring colors.

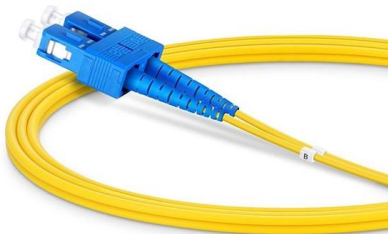

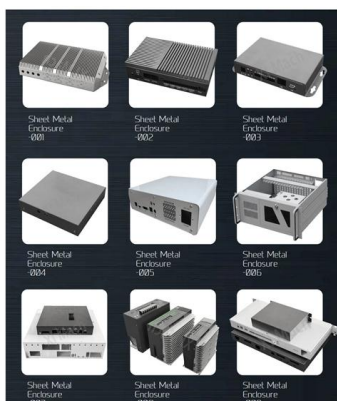

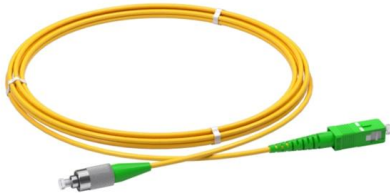
ANSI Z535.1-2022: Standard for Safety Colors
