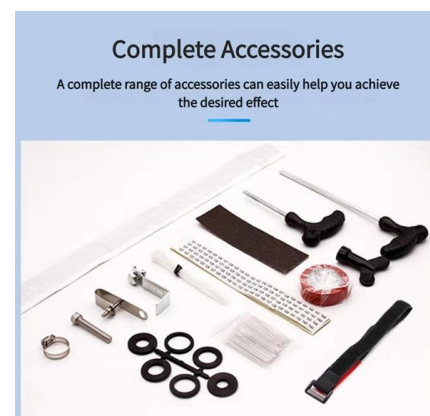

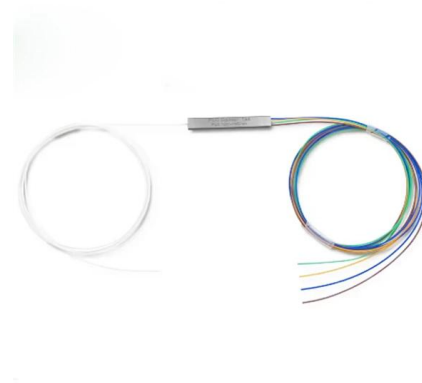


Secondary unit substations design guide

Electricity powers almost every system in all three primary applications, therefore secondary distribution is very, very important (duh) Secondary voltages occur after the distribution transformer.

The secondary circuit refers to the low-voltage circuit used for control, protection, measurement, and signal indication, which is different from the primary circuit (main circuit, carrying large current).

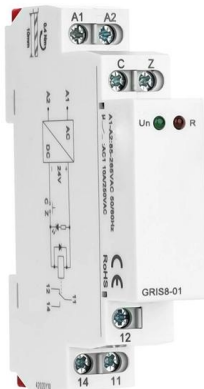
