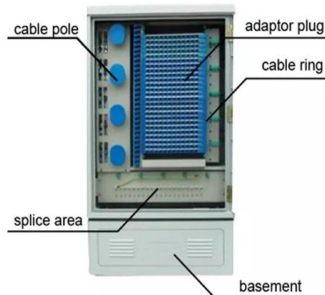


Overview
