A typical full-size rack is 42U, which means it holds just over 6 feet (180 cm) of equipment, and a typical "half-height" rack is 18U-22U, which is around 3 feet (91 cm) high. The mounting-hole distance (as shown to the right) differs for 19-inch racks and 23-inch racks: 19-inch racks use uneven spacings (as shown to the right) while 23-inch. A "U" rack dimension stands for a rack unit and refers to the height of a device that can be mounted in the server rack. Important: U describes height only, but a server's real "capabilities" are also determined by chassis depth, internal layout, airflow, rails, power, and expansion (PCIe/risers, NVMe).
